

**AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO
CDBG SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN
CITY OF BETHLEHEM
AND
REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM**

This AMENDMENT No. 3 to Community Development Block Grant subrecipient agreement is entered into as of this _____ day of _____, 2026 (this "Amendment"), by and between the CITY OF BETHLEHEM, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as the "Grantee," and the **REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF BETHLEHEM**, hereinafter referred to as "Subrecipient." Grantee and Subrecipient, shall together be referred to herein as the "parties."

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Grantee and subrecipient entered into a Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") subrecipient agreement, dated January 2, 2024 (the "Original Agreement"), amended by Amendment No. 1, dated January 2, 2024, and Amendment No. 2, dated June 10, 2025 (the original agreement, as amended, being the "Agreement") in connection with the program year 2022 CDBG activity referred to as RDA-Program Administration. HUD Integrated Disbursement and Information System (IDIS) information: **IDIS activity No. 1689** (2022/1); and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement by extending the Term of the Agreement and Subrecipient's time of performance and to amend the CDBG activity matrix code.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, and of the benefits that will accrue to Grantee and Subrecipient, and intending to be legally bound, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Effective as of December 31, 2025, the Term of the Agreement, defined in Section 3 of the Original Agreement, is hereby extended through December 31, 2026.
2. The CDBG matrix code applicable to the Activity under the Agreement is hereby amended to be CDBG matrix code 21A (General Program Administration). The Agreement is hereby amended, wherever applicable and as applicable, to delete references to matrix codes 14G and 17C and to delete any associated CDBG national objective and accomplishment text, and replace with references to matrix code 21A and related national objective and accomplishment provisions. For reference, the Original Agreement contains matrix code-specific content in several sections, including without limitation, in the following sections: 1.A.1 (General Statement); 1.B (National Objectives); 1.C (Levels of Accomplishment - Goals and Performance Measures); and 2 (Eligibility Citation). Notwithstanding the forgoing, the City may unilaterally modify the forgoing matrix code and national objective and accomplishment information, from time to time, if necessary or advisable to comply with applicable U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development guidance and/or applicable law or regulation.
3. Section 1.C of the Original Agreement shall retain the heading, but is amended to delete the existing non-heading text and replace it with the following: "21A (General Program Administration)."
4. In Section 2 of the Original Agreement (Eligibility Citation), the existing matrix codes and eligibility citations are hereby deleted and replaced with the following: "21A (General Program Administration) activity: 24 CFR 570.206."

5. In Amendment No. 2, in the first WHEREAS background paragraph, the CDBG activity title and IDIS identification number text reading “Bethlehem Redevelopment Authority Acquisition and Rehabilitation of Real Property (RDA- Housing Rehab IDIS ID No. 1519)” is hereby deleted and replaced with the following text: “RDA-Program Administration. IDIS activity No. 1689 (2022/1).”
6. The Background paragraphs above are incorporated into this Amendment by reference, as if fully set forth herein.
7. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
